(Some moisture-resistant thin formulations are available with CARB 2 certification upon request.)

This transition will be seamless with no change whatsoever in the product quality and customer service you have come to rely on from Plum Creek. We ask for your assistance in working through remaining inventories of CARB 1 products in our field and mill warehouses, and believe this proactive step will help us all be better prepared for the coming implementation dates.

Moreover, we believe this advancement will provide you with a competitive edge when selecting our Glacier Green™ or Glacier Clear™ products for your low emission requirements:

Glacier Green: CARB Phase 2 and remaining CARB Phase 1 inventories.

Glacier Clear: No-added formaldehyde and no-added urea-formaldehyde formulations that are also CARB Phase 2 compliant.
